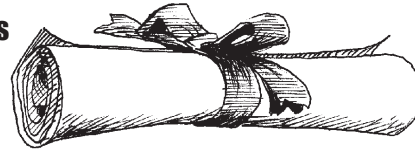

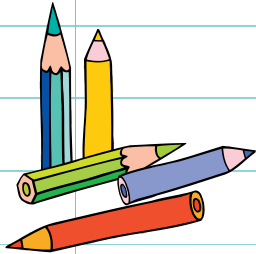
Are you interested in how you can contribute to the success of Port Catholic? Do you enjoy working with technology? Wondering how you can fulfill your volunteer commitments? If so, I am looking for someone who can 'shadow' me to take over the computer work for the Key Event Auction, using a purchased auction software package. This would be a 2+ year commitment, shadowing the first year, working independently the 2nd year, and then mentoring the next volunteer. This is a 'behind the scenes' opportunity, and there are no expectations for any type of solicitation.

Duties include:

- **Preparation** of auction donor solicitation lists and letters (late summer), and assistance with stuffing and mailing
- **Attendance** at periodic meetings with other auction co-chairs
- **Entering** donated item information, as well as attendees and table assignments into the auction database
- **Running** reports and providing prior historical auction information to other volunteers
- **Preparation** of information for the auction booklet and addendum
- **Procurement** of supplies and services (paper, envelopes, labels, ink, printing services, postage, etc.)
- **Oversight** of design, preparation and printing the auction booklet
- **Printing**, preparation, assembly, and distribution of:
 - Advance information packets for attendees
 - Night-of-auction registration packets
 - Gift certificates
 - Bid Sheets
 - Miscellaneous reports for night-of-auction workers
 - Donor thank you letters and receipts
- **Running** periodic backups of the auction database, as well as a 'final' backup after the auction is completed and all information is entered.
- **Facilitating** payment for auction software maintenance

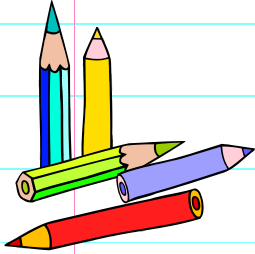

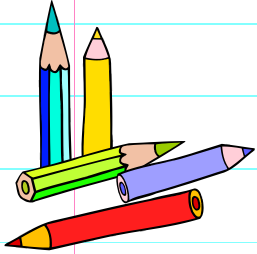

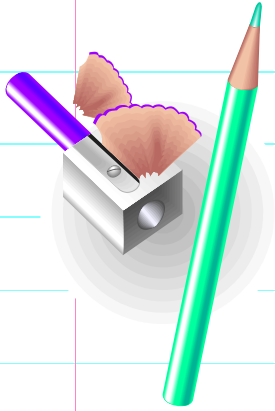
